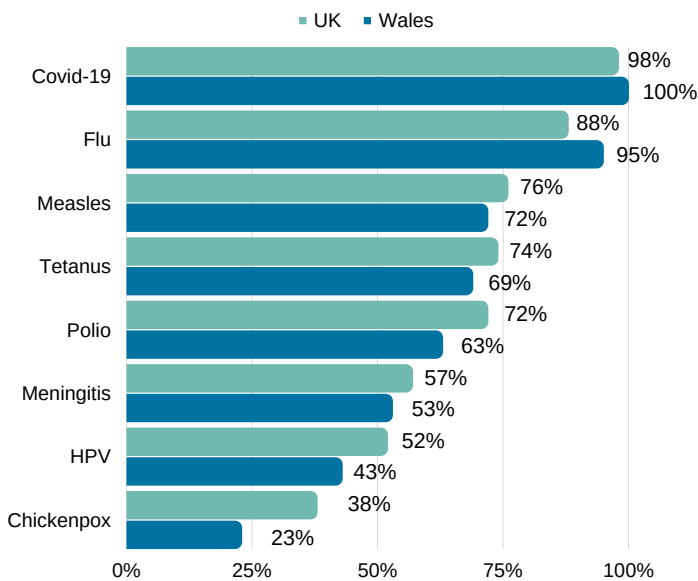


Wales

RSPH surveyed* 11-16 year-old Children and Young People (CYP) from across the UK. Below is a summary of what CYP in Wales told us about their attitudes towards vaccines**.

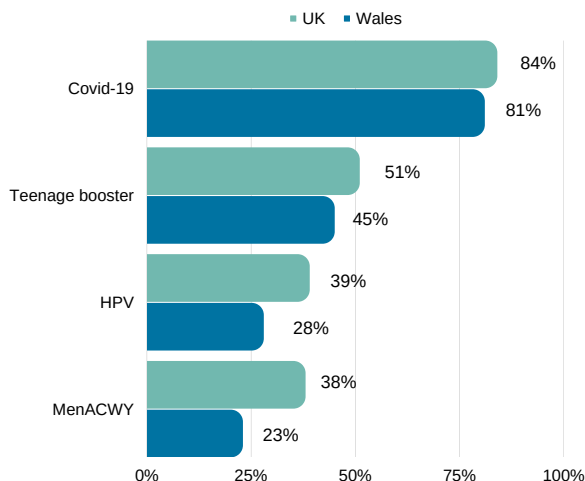


% of CYP who think there is a vaccine for each one of the diseases below:







With the exception of Covid-19 and Flu, CYP in Wales are less aware of which diseases have a vaccine.

They are also less aware of which vaccines are available to them.

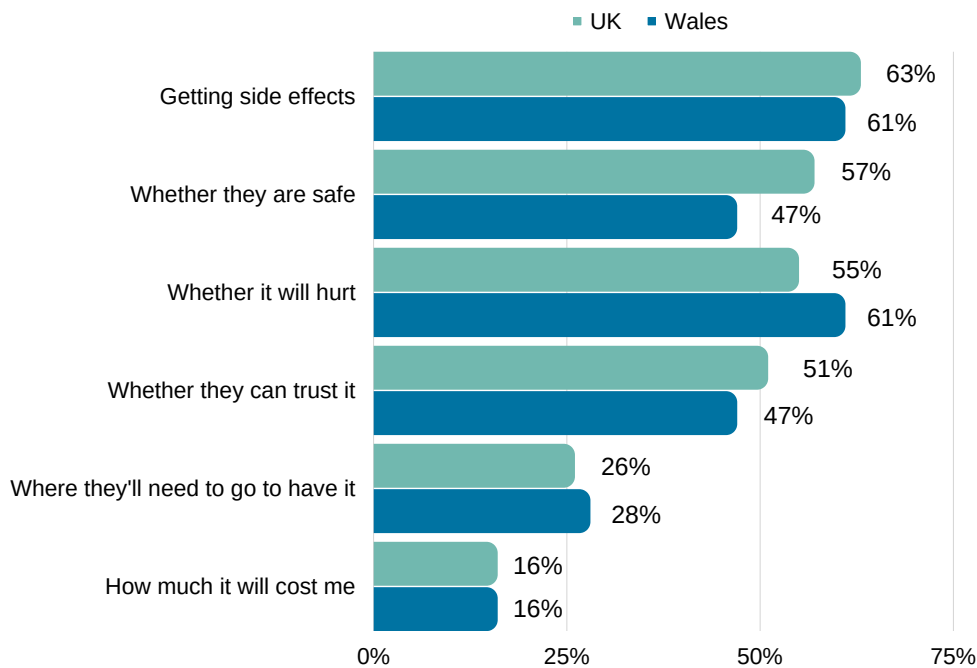
