


## % of CYP who think there is a vaccine for each one of the diseases below:




Compared to the UK as a whole, CYP in Scotland are more likely to know which diseases have a vaccine (with the exception of tetanus and meningitis).

## % of CYP who think the vaccine below is available to them:


They are also more likely to know which vaccines are available to them.
