

RSPH Online Examination Violation Checklist

The following events / Activities carried out by a candidate during an on-line examination may result in the examination for that candidate being annulled.

- Looking at mobile phone/tablet
- Wearing of any earplugs, AirPods or headphones
- Continuously looking around room (up, down, to the left or to the right)
- Wearing of any clothing with the ability to hide materials i.e., hooded jumper
- Leaving room
- Looking at hands or wrists
- Accessing web pages
- Accessing other applications, such as Word/Excel or their folders/windows explorer
- Taking screenshots of exam content
- Other people entering the room
- Communicating with others face to face or electronically
- Using Smart Devices (Smart Watches, Virtual Assistance (Alexa or Google Assistant))
- Using multiple screens
- Use of textbooks or notes
- Notes around the room
- Room is too dark
- Wearing sunglasses or smart glasses (without a need to do so)
- Web cam on laptop angled up/face obscured
- Inappropriate behaviour and language will not be tolerated
