Health Protection

We

- help people make informed choices that protect their health and wellbeing
- advise on infection prevention and control

Wider Determinants

- equip children and young people to reach their potential
 - help people access, stay in and return to employment including through certification of fit notes
 - adapt people's homes so they can fully participate in daily life
 - work with fire services to design home fire safety checks





Population Healthcare

We

- diagnose developmental delays in children and young people
- provide rehabilitation and reablement
- remove barriers to people moving about in their homes and communities
- deliver cognitive and mental health rehabilitation and recovery
- get people back to work through vocational rehabilitation

Health Improvement

We

- deliver falls prevention and home hazard assessments
- encourage behaviour change and adoption of healthy occupations and lifestyle choices
- advise on managing mental health and wellbeing
- find solutions to keep people connected with their communities, families and friends
