
## **2019 UPDATE IMPACT PATHWAYS** – Dementia



Supportive resources: There are dementia training resources available on the NHS Health Checks website.

The dementia profile within the <u>Dementia Intelligence Network</u> provides national data relating to dementia and can be broken down thematically, geographically and analysed at local level. The Public Health England (PHE) framework 'All our health' has a section dedicated to <u>dementia</u>, containing extensive literature on the different forms intervention can take.

\*Mild cognitive impairment is a syndrome defined as cognitive decline greater than expected for an individual's age and education level, which does not interfere notably with activities of daily living. It is not a diagnosis of dementia of any type, although it may lead to dementia in some cases.

\*\*Follow-up is optional and in many cases will not be possible. However, should the opportunity arise, the impact pathway highlights the data that could be collected to further demonstrate impact.
